## ORDINANCE NO. 20-02

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SEWER SERVICE CHARGES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Auburn, Iowa:

Passed by the Council the 13th

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 99.01 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Auburn, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

99.01 SEWER SERVICE CHARGES REQUIRED. Each customer shall pay sewer service charges for the use of and for the service supplied by the municipal sanitary sewer system based upon the amount of water consumed as follows:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 384.84)

- 1. Base Rate, including first 1,000 gallons per month - \$30.00.
- 2. All over 1,000 gallons used per month - \$6.00 per 1,000 gallons.

In no case shall the minimum service charge be less than the base rate, per household or business building per month, which is necessary to retire the indebtedness, operating and maintenance, and reserve necessary for maintaining the sanitary sewer facility.

On January 1, 2021, all sewer rates shall be increased by 3.0% over the rates established above. On each January 1 thereafter, all sewer rates shall be increased by 3.0% over the rates in effect during the preceding year.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
