**A RESOLUTION ENUNCIATING THE  
CITY OF AUBURN'S SEWER FORGIVENESS POLICY**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Auburn, Iowa, oversees the City's sewer utility.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Auburn, Iowa, desires to formally enunciate the City's policy towards sewer charge forgiveness.


**WHEREAS**, Chapter 99, Section 1, of the City Code of Auburn, Iowa, sets sewer rates based upon the amount of monthly water usage of a customer.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Auburn, Iowa, finds that the City should enunciate its City policy according to which sewer charges based upon actual water usage will not be forgiven for any reason.


**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF AUBURN, IOWA THAT:**

That the policy of the City of Auburn, Iowa, is hereby enunciated that the City shall not forgive sewer charges, as incurred based upon actual water usage, for any reason.
