WHEREAS, the City Council of Auburn, Iowa, and Iowa Department of Transportation jointly maintain primary roads located within city limits of Auburn, Iowa; and,

WHEREAS, attached hereto is an Agreement for Maintenance and Repair of Primary Roads in Municipalities which proposes to renew the terms of the current five year agreement between the City and the Iowa DOT for road maintenance for another five year term, beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2026.
